Promoting Positive Youth Development

Three years ago, South Sioux City Community School District-- one of nineteen school districts nation wide-- was awarded federal dollars to create a safe school environment, reduce student use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs, offer student social and emotional support, improve access to mental health, and provide for early childhood services.

Did you know? Grant funds from the U.S. Depts. of Education, Health and Human Services and Justice provided free parenting classes in Love and Logic; school safety cameras, safety and vulnerability studies, crisis preparedness; mental health nurses and mental health services; student assistance team coordinators; a social worker; mentoring program; curriculum enrichment opportunities; a social skill

curriculum; transportation to early childhood schooling; an after school program; diverse training opportunities for teachers; an elementary school liaison officer; an automated phone system to communicate with parents; and a website dedicated to sharing information with the community (www.sshs.nebraska.org).

Funding for this grant is now ending, but the limited remaining dollars and the commitment of the community partners will continue to support the original objectives. Sustaining the outcomes of the initiative will promote positive youth development in this thriving community. The Safe School Healthy Students initiative through Cardinal Connections is one of many sources of community pride!
